This contempt petition has been filed alleging non-compliance of the order dated 01.05.2014, passed in C.W.J.C. No. 7432 of 2014, contents whereof is quoted hereinbelow :

“2 01.05.2014 We have heard counsel for the petitioner and the State.

In this Public Interest Litigation, the grievance is with regard to the failure to construct a public road by the Road Construction Department of the State Government.

The matter is referred to the Principal Secretary,

Road Construction Department as the petitioner alleges that the construction of the road remains pending since the year 2006.

The application is disposed.”

There being no direction issued by the High Court, contempt petition is absolutely misconceived, which is dismissed.
