Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and
learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application for grant of anticipatory bail
arises out of Mohiuddin Nagar P.S. Case No.78 of 2015,
disclosing offences under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307,
504 and 379/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

From the First Information Report, it appears
that the occurrence took place in a social function over
some petty dispute between the petitioners and the
informant's side.

Learned counsel, appearing on behalf of the
petitioners, submits that no material in course of
investigation has been collected to support the

prosecution case with respect to commission of offence under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering the nature of accusation, this application is allowed. Let the petitioners, abovenamed, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of **learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Samastipur** in connection with **Mohiuddin Nagar P.S. Case No.78 of 2015**, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioners shall present themselves before the police/Court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on their part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, their bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
