ORAL JUDGMENT

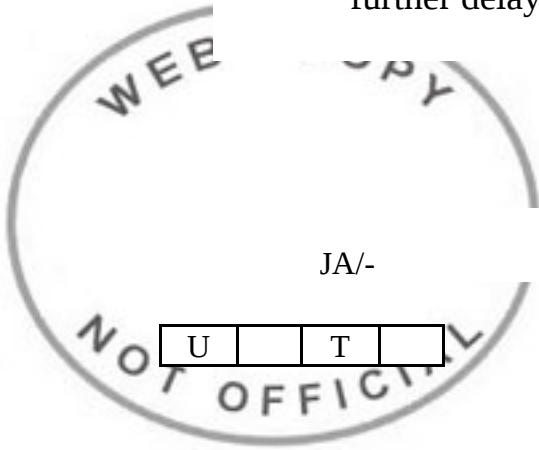

Considering that on merits the Sessions Judge,
