Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case under
Section 307 and other sections of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant Circle Officer made allegations
against the petitioner that the petitioner barged into his chambers,
snatched his wrist watch and threw records on the table of the
informant. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
allegations are false and concocted. No such occurrence has taken
place. The petitioner demanded some information under the R.T.I.
Act and, on such, this case has been lodged.

It appears that the Circle Officer made very specific
allegations that the petitioner humiliated the informant, snatched
his wrist watch and threw files on his table. Hence, I am not

inclined to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the same is rejected.

The petitioner, if so advised, may surrender in the court below and make prayer for regular bail. The court below shall consider the prayer for regular bail of the petitioner on the same day, without being prejudiced from this order.
