Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the
State.

The Petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case
instituted for the offence under Section(s) 323, 498-A Indian
Penal Code and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

In the nature of dispute, notice had been issued to
the Opposite Party No.2, but none appears on her behalf.

Considering the merits of the case, it is ordered that
in the event of surrender/arrest of the Petitioner, named above,
within four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy
of this order in connection with Complaint Case No.1123 of
2008/T.R. No.2064 of 2013, he shall be released on anticipatory
bail on furnishing bail bond of ₹5,000/- (five thousand) with two
sureties of the like amount each or any other surety to be fixed by

the court below to the satisfaction of the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Rosera, subject to the conditions as laid down under sections 438(2) Cr. P. C. and (i) That one of the bailors will be a close relative of the Petitioner, who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the Petitioner. The bailors will undertake to furnish information to the court about any change in the address of the Petitioner, (ii) That the Petitioner will be well represented on each date and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail will be liable to be cancelled.

The Petitioner volunteers to deposit ₹750/- (seven hundred fifty) per month in the court below firstly within fifteen days from today and subsequently by 15th every month which the wife of the Petitioner will be at liberty to withdraw without prejudice the right of the parties. However, if the Complainant/Informant has a Bank Account or subsequently opens a Bank Account, the money shall be deposited in the Account and a receipt to this effect shall be filed by 15th every month in the Court below and in case he fails to do so, his bail shall stand cancelled.
