Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

It is submitted by learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners that petitioner no.5, Rikhi Nonia has been arrested.

Hence, his application has become infructuous.

The petitioners are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 448, 341, 323, 379, 307 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of making assault and snatching earring.

It is submitted by learned Senior Counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are agnates of the informant and in the background of serious land dispute, the accusation has been levelled when the injury has been found to be superficial simple in

nature. A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioner nos. 1 to 4 be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned J.M., 1st Class, Bhojpur at Ara in connection with Sandesh P.S. Case No. 111 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
