Having regard to the admitted position that the petitioner is a Panchayat Teacher and is aggrieved by an order dated 05.05.2015 contemplating to terminate her services, this Court would find the present writ application to be premature and ill advised for a simple reason that the petitioner has a statutory alternative remedy under Rule 18 of the Bihar Panchayat Elementary Teachers (Employment & Service Conditions) Rules, 2006/2012.

When such an observation has been made, Ms. Mahasweta Chatterjee, learned counsel for the petitioner, seeks permission to withdraw this writ application in order to enable the petitioner to file an appeal before the Tribunal.

This writ application is accordingly permitted to be withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.
