3 09-01-2015 Heard Mr. Jitendra Prasad Singh who has appeared on behalf of the petitioner and Mr. Tej Bahadur Singh who has appeared on behalf of respondent no. 4.

A preliminary objection has been raised by the respondents that the writ application seeking relief against the Managing Committee of Indu Tapeswar Singh Mahila College, Bikramganj, Rohtas is not maintainable. He relies in this regard on two orders passed in respect of the same College copies whereof have been handed in by Mr. Tej Bahadur Singh which have been taken on record and marked 'X' and 'Y' for identification. He also relies on a Full Bench judgment of this Court since reported in **1987**

P.L.J.R. 964.

Mr. Singh, Counsel for the petitioner, after making some submissions, states that the petitioner, instead of pressing this application, would approach once again the respondent Principal Secretary, Government of Bihar for redressal of his grievance.
