In view of limited prayer made at the time of
hearing of this application, the same is being disposed of
granting liberty to the petitioner to move before a
competent forum which would be available to him under
law.

Let the impugned notice be not given effect
for further four weeks. In the meantime, the petitioner
would be at liberty to approach the concerned competent
forum itself for grant of interim relief. While considering
such prayer made by the petitioner, such competent forum
would be required to take a decision without being
prejudiced by any observation or interim relief granted in

this case and would proceed further to take a final decision in the matter also on its own merit and in accordance with law.
