2 18-12-2015 Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends her arrest in Haspura P.S.
Case No. 79/2014, registered for the offences punishable under
Section 304B and other sections of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is the mother-in-law of the deceased. The
prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner was earlier rejected
vide order dated 21.05.2015 passed in Cr. Misc. 6013/2015.

It is submitted that the husband and father-in-law of the
deceased have already been acquitted and none of the prosecution
witnesses have supported the prosecution case.

Considering the fact that the prayer for anticipatory bail
of the petitioner has already been rejected vide order dated

21.05.2015, but even after lapse of seven months, the petitioner did not surrender, I do not find any fresh ground to consider the prayer for anticipatory bail. Accordingly, the same is rejected.
