2 14-08-2015 Learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that the tenure of the orders impugned contained in Annexures 2 and 3 having already lapsed, this writ application has become infructuous as a permanent Committee has already been constituted by the Board.

Accordingly, this writ application stands disposed of as having become infructuous.

However, it is made clear that this order would not affect the right of the petitioner to challenge the legality of the constitution of the Trust Committee under Section 32 of the Bihar Hindu Religious Trusts Act, 1950 before a competent forum.
