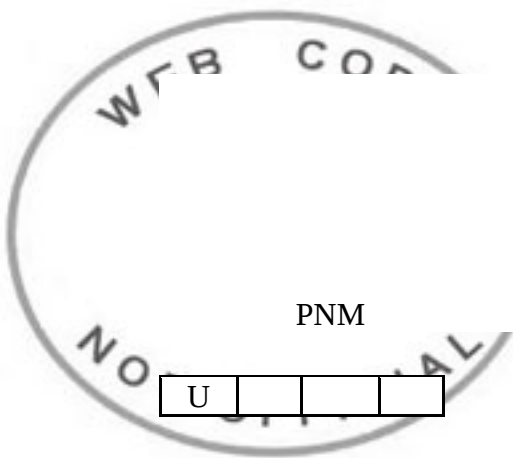
3 17-03-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
