learned Special PP for the State.

Although instant case was registered on the basis of
complaint petition but there is allegation against the
petitioner that he and one co-accused Krishna Rawat took
the informant towards a hillock and not only assaulted,
looted but co-accused Krishna Rawat committed rape upon
her.

The case has been registered under the provision of
the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act. Therefore, in my
view, section 18 of the SC/ST (Prevention of Atrocities)
Act, 1989 is applicable and this anticipatory bail petition is
not maintainable. Accordingly, this petition filed in
connection with Jamui Mahila P. S. case no. 23/2014 stands

dismissed being not maintainable.

However, at the time of consideration of regular bail application of the petitioner, observation given in this order shall not prejudice to the concerned court.
