3 21-07-2015 The petitioners have questioned the orders passed by the authorities under the settlement manual. The order passed by the Additional Collector, Rohtas in Settlement Appeal Case No. 3 of 1996-97 partially confirming the order passed by the Circle Officer in Settlement Case No. 56 of 1982 / 566 of 1983, copy of which orders are placed at Annexure- 6 and 7 respectively.

In view of the provisions underlying Section 9 of the Bihar Land Tribunal Act (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') and in view of the enactments listed thereunder, the petitioner should exhaust the alternative remedy so available to him.
