The Petitioner seeks bail in Buxar (T) P.S. case No.122
of 2014 instituted for the offence under Sections 394 and 302 of
the Indian Penal Code, pending in the court of the C.J.M., Buxar.

Considering that incriminating articles of the deceased
were kept by the Petitioner in the house of one Barmeshwar Nath
Seth and his own cousin sister has disclosed his complicity, I am
not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

of the seriousness of the nature of the offence.
