Much has happened since filing of the writ application as well as the original challenge thrown up to the order of transfer, contained in Annexure-6.

In view of the above, prima facie, writ has become infructuous because of subsequent developments and decisions have emerged.

The Court, therefore, gives liberty to the petitioner to file an application before the Principal Secretary, Health, Government of Bihar, with the grievance in relation to the transfer, keeping in mind the so-called seniority of the petitioner etc. as well as the decision

rendered by this Court, which is Annexure-7 to the writ application. If such an application is filed, a decision will be rendered within a period of six weeks thereof.

Writ application is disposed of with above direction.
