The petitioner has questioned the order passed in favour
of the private respondent no. 4 by the Collector, Bhojpur whereby
the Collector while setting aside the order of the Deputy Collector
Land Reforms has confirmed the order of the Circle Officer,
Udwanthnagar, District-Bhojpur passed on 21.7.1997 in Mutation
Case No. 229 of 1997-98 whereunder the order of mutation in the
name of the private respondent was allowed.

This writ petition has stood dismissed as against the

private respondent for non-compliance of the peremptory order dated 27.12.2004 and thus has been rendered incompetent and cannot proceed in his absence.
