We have, in a separate judgment, delivered today, upheld the constitutional validity of "Article 3.3.3 of the Statues for appointment of teachers (Assistant Professor Grade) for the Universities of Bihar, 2014" and the marking scheme contemplated in Schedule-V of the said Statutes, in a batch of

writ applications, the leading case being **C.W.J.C. Nos.18016 of 2012 (Dr. Rakesh Kumar Singh & Ors. vs. The Union of India & Ors.)**. Similar issues have been raised in these two writ applications, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, which are dismissed in terms of our decision aforesaid.
