ORAL ORDER

6 10-02-2015 After some arguments, in view of passage of time, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, in presence of the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents, seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with a liberty to approach the respondent no.5 for refund of security money, if any, deposited by the petitioner for allotment of contract on the basis of impugned advertisement as contained in Annexure-1.

Permission is accorded.

The writ petition stands disposed of as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

It is clarified that if the petitioner had deposited any security money for allotment of the contract in question and if he files a representation before the respondent no.5, then the respondent no.5 either himself or any other competent authority shall consider his case in accordance with law and shall dispose it of at an early date preferably within a period of two months from the date of filing the representation by the petitioner.
