This Court regrets to observe that all accounting as well as utilization certificates which the petitioner has to offer to the respondent authorities are not subject matter which will come under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

It is for the petitioner to satisfy the authorities about the payments which he has received under various heads and its proper utilization or else he may file an appropriate suit in this regard but the writ is not the answer of such disputes.

Writ application is dismissed with above liberty.
