4 16-04-2015 This application has been dismissed as having become infurctuous so far as it relates to petitioners No. 1 and 5 by an order dated 24.12.2014 read with the order dated 02.04.2015.

This is thus an application seeking anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner Nos. 2,3,4,6 and 7 in case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148,149, 341,323,325, 307, 379, 435 and 109 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners appears to be correct in his submission that in similar circumstance other co

accused persons have been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 27.3.2015 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 43345 of 2014 and Cr. Misc. No. 42758 of 2014.

In view of the above, let petitioner nos. 2,3,4,6 and 7 above named, in the event of their arrest/surrender within four weeks from today, in the Court below be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Buxar in Chansoi P.S. Case No. 94 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
