ORAL ORDER

3 29-04-2015 Perused the show cause reply filed on behalf of Central Co-operative Bank, Aurangabad through its officials, who are opposite parties.

It appears that the order dated 18.04.2014 passed in C.W.J.C.No. 4298 of 2014 has been complied with. The order has been passed on petitioner's representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the opposite party has done mere formality disposing of the petitioners' representation and no proper reason has been

assigned for rejecting the petitioners’ claim.

I do not find any substance in the submission of learned counsel for the petitioners. If, according to the petitioners, reason assigned by the opposite party is not proper and not in accordance with law, it will be open to the petitioners to question in accordance with law before an appropriate forum.

This application stands disposed of.
