APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest for the offences
alleged under Sections 467, 468, 471, 420, 120B/34, 504 and 447
of the Indian Penal Code registered in connection with Amas P.S.
Case No. 130 of 2015.

3. It is submitted that the petitioner is merely a deed-
writer and has no interest for the subject matter nor has received
any consideration amount.

4. Learned counsel for the informant suo motu appears.

5. Having regard to the entirety of the facts and
circumstances of the case, in the event of the petitioner's arrest or
surrender before the court below within six weeks from the date of
communication of this order, let the above named petitioner be

released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Sherghati, District Gaya in connection with Amas P.S. Case No. 130 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C., and also subject to the following further conditions:

(i) The petitioner shall cooperate with the investigation and make himself available as and when so required and in case of failure, the State shall be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail.

(ii) The petitioner shall remain physically present on each and every date during trial and in the event of failure on two consecutive dates, his bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled by the learned Court concerned.
