This Court finds it strange that a person, who is already convicted by a court for serious omission and commission, still continues to be in government service. Why this special privilege is being extended to the petitioner can best be explained by the respondents or the superior authority.

The Principal Secretary, Road Construction Department will look into the matter immediately and take an appropriate decision. The issue whether the petitioner should be kept under suspension or he has to be dismissed should be decided within a period of four weeks from the date of production of a copy of this

order.
