ORAL ORDER

4 31-08-2015 After having heard the parties, this Court finds that with respect to lands under dispute, detailed in paragraph 1 of the writ petition, the petitioners, besides others, have already filed Title Suit No. 381 of 2008 for grant of appropriate relief (s), which is pending before the learned Subordinate Judge-1, Bhabua.
