ORAL ORDER

3 20-02-2015 Following is the prayer made in the present application
under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

“For quashing of the entire proceeding including the first information report of vigilance P.S. Case No. 046 of 2009 dated 30.04.2009 (Spl. Case No. 35 of 2009) for the offence under Sections 109/120(B) of the Indian Penal Code, Section 13(i) D II along with 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act and Sections 135/138 of the Electricity Act, 2003.”

Counter affidavits have been filed on behalf of the opposite parties which are there on record.

Learned counsel representing the Bihar State Electricity Board as well as learned Senior Counsel representing the

Vigilance Department have vehemently opposed the prayer made in the present application.
