learned APP for the State.

I do not see it a fit case whereunder there happens to be any scope for reconsideration of anticipatory bail as the same stood rejected vide order dated 23.03.2015 under Cr.Misc.No.31014/2014. Accordingly, petitions for anticipatory bail filed on behalf of petitioners no. 1, 2 and 3 are rejected.

So far petitioner no.4, Nand Lal Singh is concerned, his case stands on similar footing as that of petitioners who had been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 23.04.2014 under Cr.Misc.No.31014/2014 and in the aforesaid background,

petitioner no. 4, Nand Lal Singh, in the event of arrest/surrender within four weeks, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Vaishali at Hajipur in connection with Rajapakar P.S. Case No.118/2013, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
