Heard counsel for the petitioner, counsel for the State
as well as counsel appearing on behalf of Bihar Sanskrit Shiksha
Board.

The only reason why the claim for recognition of the
institution was rejected by the Joint Secretary, Education Department,
Government of Bihar on 22.07.2011 as per Annexure-9 is
insufficiency of fund in the security fund/security money.

Submission of the counsel for the petitioner is that there
was some miscommunication because subsequently Bihar Sanskrit

Shiksha Board has informed the State that the actual balance available under the said head is said to be Rs. 88,989/-.

In view of the same, the writ application is disposed of with a direction upon the respondent-state authorities to reconsider the matter and take a fresh decision within a reasonable time frame preferably within a period of six months from the date of production of a copy of this order.
