Heard Shri Ajay Kumar Thakur, the learned counsel
appearing on behalf of the petitioners.

2. The petition challenges the order dated
26.07.2007 by which the learned Special Judge, Vigilance-I, Patna
took cognizance of offences under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471,
477A, 120B and 109 of the Indian Penal Code and Section
13(1)(c)(d) read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption
Act.

3. After having heard the learned counsel for the
petitioners and considering that the court has only summoned the
petitioners to stand trial and avenues are still open to the
petitioners to vent their grievances before the Special Court itself
as was the view of the Supreme Court in Khacheru Singh Vs. State

of Uttar Pradesh & Anr. reported in (1982) 3 SCC 218, the petition is dismissed.

4. Petitioners shall have the liberty to agitate the submissions before the learned Special Judge, Vigilance-I, Patna.
