State.

Petitioners are apprehending their arrest in

connection with a case registered for the offence under Sections
354A, 385, 379 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that earlier
petitioner no.1 was attacked at the instance of the informant of the
present case as he asked the informant to return the amount which
he had given to her and then to take back the hand note but she
refused to do so and managed attack on petitioner no.1 whereafter

petitioner no.1 filed complaint case on 26.06.2015 and the present case has been filed on 03.07.2015 by way of defence to the said case.

Let petitioners surrender in the court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Harsidhi P.S. Case No. 245 of 2015 within four weeks from the date of receipt/ production of a copy of this order whereafter the court below shall examine the injury report which was generated after petitioner no.1 suffered injuries prior to filing of the complaint case on 26.06.2015 and in case petitioner no.1 suffered grievous injuries, petitioners above named be admitted to the privilege of bail, amount whereof shall be fixed by the court below, otherwise the court below shall pass appropriate order in the matter in accordance with law.
