5 30-09-2015 The present writ petition has been filed for a direction to the respondents to permit the petitioner to conclude the execution of work assigned to the petitioner under the heading 4515 MMGSY Scheme vide order dated 17.05.2010 and agreement dated 20.05.2010, by which the construction of the Khagaria Bakhari PWD Road to Ramunia village after Kathoura, Railway Station crossing was ordered to be constructed by the petitioner and for connected reliefs.
