GA-1, makes a prayer for disposal of the present petition, so that

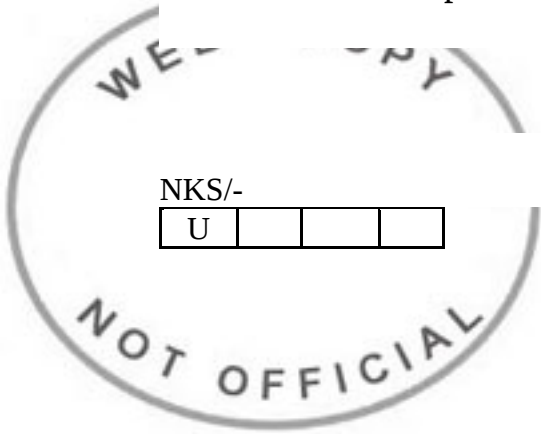
the petitioners may avail statutory remedy.
