Having regard to the facts and circumstances of this

case, the same is being disposed of with a direction to the licensing authority to take a final decision in accordance with law within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order taking into considering the Family Heirloom policy as well as the decision of this Court rendered in **Manish Kumar and others vrs. The State of Bihar and others** [2015(4)PLJR 212.
