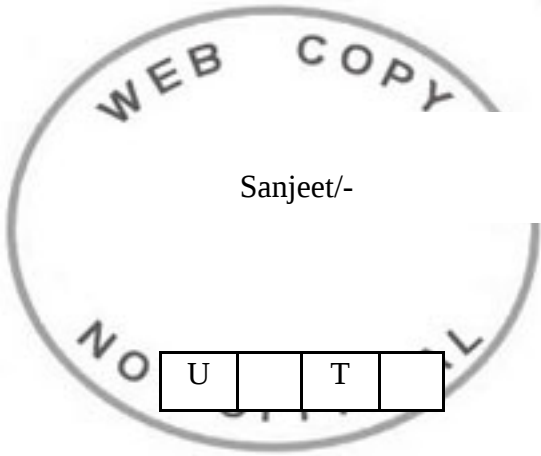
petitioners seeks leave to withdraw this application in order to
