In compliance of the order of the Writ Court dated 04.09.2015 Collector, Saharsa has included the name of the petitioner in the panel prepared on 15.10.2014 at Serial No. 23 'ka'. In remarks column No. 9 of the panel there is further entry that petitioner has been included in the panel in the light of the direction of the High Court.

Counsel for the State Sri Arbind Kumar No. 1, SC-13 states that petitioner in spite of his inclusion in the panel at serial No. 23 'ka' could not be given appointment letter as above him there are 23 persons and until those 23 persons are accommodated and given

appointment petitioner has to wait for his turn. In case, petitioner is aggrieved by the place which he has been given in the panel dated 15.10.2014 or should have been included in any other earlier panel he should be well advised to file another writ petition.
