ORAL ORDER

Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case under
Sections 341, 323, 354 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation is that the petitioner showed torch
light while the daughter of the informant was answering call of
nature on 19.08.2015 at 6.30 P.M.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
instant case is a counter blast to the earlier case filed by the
petitioner against the prosecution side in which he alleged that the
prosecution side assaulted him on the ground that he misbehaved
with his family members.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the
case, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below
within six weeks from today the above named petitioner be

released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5000/- (Five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Jigar Shah, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Gaya in connection with Tekari (Panchanpur O.P.) P.S. Case no. 333 of 2015 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. with the condition that he will not physically absent for two consecutive dates at stretch till charge is framed.
