Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners being the parents of the husband of the informant are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The basic accusation is of torture after nine years of the marriage.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the thrust of accusation is against the husband of the informant.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the

satisfaction of the learned J.M., 1st Class, Madhubani in connection with Basopatti P.S. Case No. 124 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
