By filing the present application under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has sought for issuance of a writ of mandamus commanding the respondents specially respondent no. 2 to transfer the petitioner from Saharsa to Arwal as mother of the petitioner aged about 70-72 years is suffering from hart disease, blood pressure, blood sugar etc. The other ground for seeking the transfer is that the wife of the

petitioner is running a school at Jehanabad and as such, it would be convenient for him to discharge his duty as a doctor if he is posted at the place of his choice at Arwal.

The application is thoroughly misconceived. It is dismissed, accordingly.
