The Petitioner seeks quashing of the order dated
11.7.2011 by which the A.D.J., F.T.C. III, Gopalganj, has rejected
the application filed under Section 228 Cr. P.C. in Sessions Trial
No.471 of 2010.

Considering that even if charge under Section 307
Indian Penal Code is framed, no prejudice would be caused to the
Petitioner and the charge can be amended at any stage of Trial, I
am not inclined to interfere in the matter.

The application stands dismissed.

The Trial Court is directed to conclude the Trial
expeditiously without granting unnecessary adjournment to any
