learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in
connection with Complaint Case No.1209 of 2013 for allegedly
having committed the offence under Section 498A of the
Indian Penal Code and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Though notices were served on O.P. No.2, she has
chosen not to appear.

Considering the nature of allegations made against
the petitioner and also that the petitioner is availing interim
protection, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his
arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of

four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order,be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Rohtas at Sasaram, in connection with Complaint Case No.1209 of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
