The present writ petition has been filed in a representative capacity by the Bihar Jharkhand Vidyut Parishad Field Kamgar Union, with a prayer to direct the respondent/Board to pay over-time dues.

It is not a specific case that which employee has not been paid overtime due. In such situation, such relief may not be

granted in representative capacity. If any member of the union or employee of the respondent/Board is aggrieved regarding non-payment of the overtime due for a particular period, he/she would be entitled to avail appropriate remedy.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
