3 15-10-2015 Despite repeated calls no one appears on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the impugned action taken against the petitioner was fully justified as the petitioner did not have the requisite funds as disclosed in Clause- 10.2 and Clause-10.3 of his application form. In course of Field Verification of credentials it is found that there was only an amount of Rs. 1,31,752/- in the petitioner's SBI Savings Account. Such amount taken together with the amount of Fixed Deposit,

N.S.C etc. disclosed at Rs. 57,332/- still falls short of the minimum requirement of fund of Rs. 2,00,000/-. It is therefore submitted that the petitioner’s candidature has rightly been cancelled.

3. Be that as it may, in view of non-appearance of the petitioner, the writ petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution.
