Nobody appears on behalf of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the Patna Municipal Corporation and the Life Insurance Corporation of India are present.

In view of the fact that the dues of the petitioner have been paid as also the fact that as and when claims are being forwarded by the Patna Municipal Corporation to the Life Insurance Corporation of India, the same after due verification are being paid, the Court finds that there is no requirement of keeping the present matter pending.

Accordingly, the writ petition stands disposed off.

However, the Court hopes that in future also as and when the claims are forwarded by the Patna Municipal Corporation to the Life Insurance Corporation of India, the same

after completing the formalities shall be taken to their logical conclusion in accordance with law expeditiously.
