It was jointly submitted by learned counsel for the parties that this matter may be referred to the Bihar Land Tribunal constituted under the Bihar Land Tribunal Act 2009 for its proper adjudication. It was submitted that the case was earlier filed relating to dispute under the Bihar Tenants Holding (Maintenance of Records) Act 1973. It was submitted that now the said Act has been repealed and

replaced by the Bihar Land Mutation Act, 2011.
