pension.

As per the counter affidavit filed on behalf of the
State, it transpires that the late husband of the petitioner was
not an employee of recognized Sanskrit school and thus no
pensionary benefit can be paid to her.

served on counsel for the petitioner in January and March, 2015, no rejoinder has been filed.

In view of the aforesaid, the Court can only presume that the petitioner does not desire to pursue the matter. Accordingly, the application stands disposed off.
