In the present case, prayer has been made by the petitioner Association for a direction to the State to adopt uniform policy relating to authorizing the petitioners and the similarly situated Stamp Vendors to sell the stamps of a maximum denomination of at least Rs.5,000/ in the same and similar manner to the stamp vendors of Patna, Ranchi, Muzaffarpur, Bhagalpur, Darbhanga, Gaya and Patna High Court.

Now-a-day, Stamps are being sold through Franking Machine. System of appointing Stamp Vendors for selling revenue stamps through Vendors has already been substituted by vending the same through Franking machine established in whole of Bihar.

In view of the changed position, this writ petition has rendered infructuous. Accordingly, it is dismissed as being infructuous.

The order has been passed in presence of counsel for the State.
