ORAL ORDER

3 24-04-2015 Heard Sri Indeshwari Prasad Mandal, learned counsel
for the petitioner and Sri Raj Nandan Prasad, learned SC No. 9.

In the present writ petition petitioner has prayed for
quashing of an order contained in letter no. 1785 dated 22.5.2008
passed by the Director, Integrated Child Development Scheme
(I.C.D.S.), Government of Bihar, Patna. By the said letter it was
decided that relatives of Government servants are not eligible for
the post of Anganbari Sevika.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view
of an order passed by a single bench of this court, the said

condition has been removed by the State Government.

In view of the facts and circumstances particularly the fact that relief, which has been sought for in the present writ petition, as admitted by learned counsel for the petitioner, has already been granted, there is no reason to keep the matter pending. If the petitioner so advised, may approach the authority concerned.

In view of changed circumstances, the writ petition stands disposed of.
