Writ application is dismissed for the reason that the dispute relates to appointment of the year 2007 and the concurrent findings are that the selection of the private respondent per say did not seem to be erroneous because her husband was found to be a resident of the ward in question. The dominant caste representing the said ward belongs to unreserved category. Petitioner comes from the Backward class community. In view of the same, no relief is required

to be granted to the petitioner by interfering with the selection and appointment of respondent no.12 as an Aaganbari Sevika.
