Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Petitioner became a victim of bifurcation of the State of Bihar into two States.

The advertisement was initially made keeping in mind the total vacancy position of the undivided Bihar. After creation of Jharkhand on 15th of November, 2000 only 2/3 vacancy remained in the State of Bihar. The other 1/3 was surrendered to the State of Jharkhand.

If this be so then the exercise done and the recommendation made by the B.P.S.C. had to be

revisited and that is the reason why the petitioner became the victim of yet another partition of the State.

Writ application is dismissed.
