ORAL JUDGMENT

Date: 13-08-2015

Petitioner will file an application before the District Magistrate, Saran at Chapra regarding his grievance of non- payment of salary for the month of December 2006 as well as January 2007 to April 2008. The reason for non-payment indicated by the petitioner is non- issuance of LPC by the concerned authority. Petitioner is now posted at Ekma block.

In a writ application of 2008, no counter affidavit has been filed as if seven years is not enough opportunity to the respondents to complete the pleadings. Instead of adjourning the matter for filing

counter affidavit and further delaying the issue, the Court directs the petitioner to file an application before the District Magistrate, Saran, who will get the grievance of the petitioner examined and take a decision within a period of eight weeks thereof.

Writ is disposed of with the above direction.
